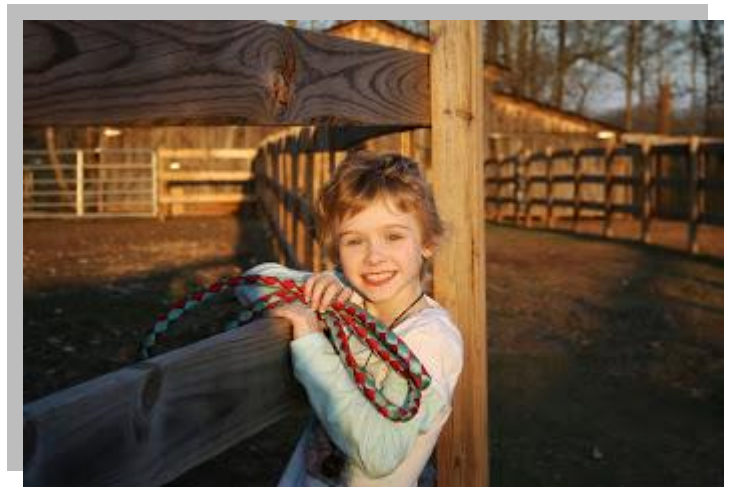
Background

The Adalin Farnum ODP Scholarships, totaling \$2,000, will be made for the purpose of enhancing ODP participants experience within the state of Michigan. Any MSYSA ODP Junior or Senior participant currently participating within the MSYSA ODP program may apply for this scholarship. \$1,000 will be awarded to a Boys ODP participant and \$1,000 will be awarded to a Girls ODP participant.

To be successful, the scholarship must be on the forms provided, must be for the exclusive use of College Tuition.

All MSYSA ODP Scholarships will be awarded on March 7, 2014 at the MSYSA Annual Awards Ceremony & Dinner. Participants who are awarded with a scholarship must have someone at the MSYSA Awards Ceremony & Dinner to receive the scholarship. If no one is present, the scholarship award is forfeited. The application will be posted on the MSYSA website at www.michiganyouthsoccer.org. Applications must be neatly typed or written.

Any attempt to use the scholarship funds inappropriately may place that participant in bad standing within the MSYSA ODP program.

MSYSA's decision on scholarship winners is final. No record of deliberations will be made. All questions about the scholarship process must be made to the MSYSA Executive Director, Thomas K. Faro. All information must be listed, all documents attached, and the package is considered complete as issued. Only one request per participant within the ODP program will be accepted. The person completing the application may or may not be called for clarification of an item or items.

The Michigan State Youth Soccer Association will make the final decision on all scholarships including amounts.

The Application Deadline is on or before Friday, January 3, 2014 by 5:00pm.

1. This program of college tuition awards is administered by the Michigan State Youth Soccer Association ODP Program.
2. Scholarships are in the form of tuition awards of \$1,000 and are to be used toward expenses in an accredited college, university, or community college beginning with the Fall of 2014.
3. This program is open to Michigan residents who have participated in the MSYSA ODP Program for 3 years or more and are graduating high school seniors.
4. Applicants must have played on a MSYSA-affiliated team for at least 6 seasons (3 years) and participated in the ODP Program.
5. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00.
6. All applicants receive notice of their status as soon as practicable after the selection process is completed.
7. Awards are contingent upon proof of acceptance and enrollment in a full-time academic program at an accredited college, university, or community college in the Fall of 2012.

Application Requirements:

Applicants **must submit** the following to MSYSA and must be received at the address listed below **NO LATER THAN JANUARY 3, 2014**.

1. A completed application form.
2. A copy of your official high school transcript (including ACT and/or SAT scores).
3. Personal biography which includes your athletic achievements, honorary or special interest organizations, community involvement, high school major, course of study you plan to pursue, awards or scholarships you have received, work record.
