What is the age requirement for ODP 101?

Male and Female players who's birth date falls between January 1, 2002 and December 31, 2004 are eligible to participate in the ODP 101 Program.

What is ODP 101?

ODP 101 is a pilot program designed to help identify the overall level of the MSYSA 11 year old player. This program will help MSYSA gauge the progress of its players, provide tangible feedback as to the future development of MSYSA players and help establish critical curriculum programs for the development of the MSYSA player.

How is this different then my club training?

The environment created will be similar players from various clubs and geographical areas who will train with similar level players. The program is to be a supplement to the club training.

Do I need to attend the ODP 101 Assessment Camp prior to the ODP 101 Training Program?

Yes. The ODP 101 Assessment Camp is used as an identification tool for the Training Program.

What is the ODP 101 Assessment Camp?

This camp is open for any player wishing to attend. The camp will be instructed by National Level Coaches. Also, the camp will be used to help identify potential players to be invited to join the ODP 101 Training Program.

There will be 5 training centers across Michigan. After the tryout camp, players can be invited into the fall and spring trainings held at the same tryout camp location.

What will be the focus of training in this Program?

MSYSA recognizes that the age-appropriate training is vital for 11 year olds. With that in mind, US Youth Soccer and US Soccer recommendations for age-appropriate and age-development training will be followed.
