How To Submit A Guest Player Form Request

(Scroll down for editing instructions)

*If you already have a coach/team administrator account, skip to step 5.

Non-MSYSA members must pay a \$20 fee and obtain a guest player passcard to be insured.

- 1. Go to www.thetournamentcenter.com
- 2. On the right hand side under "Site Login", click on Register
- 3. Click on Register under the left side paragraph about being a coach or team administrator
- **4.** Fill out the information on the page completely. *To minimize potential confusion, we recommend using the same username and password you have for GotSoccer (if you have one)* If you don't have a Team ID, enter "MSYSA" or "N/A"
- 5. On the main page, log-in using your new username and password you created.
- 6. Click Guest Player/Player Loan on the toolbar.
- 7. Click Start New Guest Player Request link.
- 8. Read the MSYSA policy on guest players in the grey box and check the "Yes" button to signify that you agree.
- 9. Make sure all information about yourself, your team ("borrowing team"), and the tournament is accurate and complete (if you don't have a Team ID, enter "N/A") Input information if it does not pre-populate.
- 10. Fill out all information about his/her team completely and accurately (if you don't have a Team and/or Team ID, enter "N/A"). The loaning team coach will receive an e-mail stating that a player from his/her team will be guest playing with another team.
- 11. Click on "Add Guest Player" and add any/all guest players for that tournament on one form.
- 12. Complete information for an electronic signature
- 13. Click Submit
- 14. Print the approved form and take it with you to the tournament. This form acts as an amendment to your existing team roster.

To Edit a Guest Player Request or Add Guest Players to an existing Request:

- 1. Log into The Tournament Center website
- 2. Click Guest Player/Player Loan on the toolbar.
- 3. Click the PENCIL / next to the name of the tournament
- 4. Make any changes, including adding/deleting guest players, and click Update
- 5. Click the PRINTER 🖶 icon corresponding to the tournament
- 6. Print the approved OFFICIAL SOCCER FORM and take it with you to the tournament
