Individual Out of State League Play Information & Fee Structure

Michigan residents wishing to play in another US Youth Soccer state association must fill out the **MSYSA Individual Out-of-State League Play Form** and pay the applicable fees before out of state permission will be granted. There are no fees assessed if a player wishes to join a state association who has partnered with Michigan and other Region II states in a cross border agreement. The application for permission to play is good for the seasonal year applied for and must be reissued every seasonal year.

Fees are consistent with the MSYSA tiered pricing structure and vary according to competition level. If you wish to play in an out of state league that is not on this list please contact MSYSA.

Per US Youth Soccer, a player may not participate for more than one club in the National Championship Series in the same seasonal year. In other words, a player may not play on a State Cup team in Michigan and also play for a State Cup team in another state within the same seasonal year.

Players currently rostered on a MSPSP team may not dual roster with an out of state MRL team or National League Team. Refer to the MSPSP Rules (Section 4.4 and Section 5.10).

Player cannot be under any disciplinary actions or sanctions by MSYSA or any other state association or one of its affiliates.
