2017 MSYSA Spring State Cup & Jr. State Cup Champions & Finalists Announced

Plymouth, Michigan (June 4, 2017) – The 2017 MSYSA Spring State Cup Champions and Finalists were named on June 4, 2017 at the Saginaw Township Soccer Complex in Saginaw, Michigan. The MSYSA State Cup Champions will advance to the US Youth Soccer Midwest Regional Championships in Sioux Falls, SD in June, 2017. Winners of the 2017 Midwest Regional Championships will advance to the US Youth Soccer National Championships hosted held in Frisco, TX in July, 2017. The 2017 MSYSA Spring State Cup featured teams in the Under-13 through the Under-19 boy age groups and Under-13 girl age groups.
