I. Current Rule:

MSYSA Rule 3.2A

A. **Youth Player.** The term "youth player" shall mean an amateur player who has not attained his or her nineteenth (19th) birthday before the first day of January of the Seasonal Year in which he or she applies for registration. For the 2020-2021 seasonal year only, the term "youth player" shall be modified to include an amateur player who has not attained his or her twentieth (20th) birthday before the first day of January of the Seasonal Year in which he or she applies for registration.

II. How the Rule Would Be Changed:

- Remove verbiage after "registration." as shown here:

A. **Youth Player.** The term "youth player" shall mean an amateur player who has not attained his or her nineteenth (19th) birthday before the first day of January of the Seasonal Year in which he or she applies for registration. ~~For the 2020-2021 seasonal year only, the term "youth player" shall be modified to include an amateur player who has not attained his or her twentieth (20th) birthday before the first day of January of the Seasonal Year in which he or she applies for registration.~~

III. Rationale:

USYS permitted the age modification for the 2020-2021 seasonal year only.
