## General Information to Applicants:

1. This program of college tuition awards is administered by the Michigan State Youth Soccer Association.
2. Scholarships are in the form of tuition awards of \$1,000 and are to be used toward expenses in an accredited college, university, or community college beginning with the Fall of 2009.
3. This program is open to Michigan residents who are participating in a bona fide soccer program and are graduating high school seniors.
4. Applicants must have played on a MSYSA-affiliated team for at least 6 seasons (3 years).
5. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75.
6. Applicants need not play college soccer to apply.
7. All applicants receive notice of their status as soon as practicable after the selection process is completed.
8. Awards are contingent upon proof of acceptance and enrollment in a full-time academic program at an accredited college, university, or community college in the Fall of 2009.

## Application Requirements:

Applicants **must submit** the following to MSYSA and must be received at the address listed below **NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 2, 2009**.

1. A completed application form.
2. A copy of your official high school transcript (including ACT and/or SAT scores).
3. One page personal biography which includes your athletic achievements, honorary or special interest organizations, community involvement, high school major, course of study you plan to pursue, awards or scholarships you have received, and a brief description of any way which you have given back to soccer, i.e. coach, referee, etc.
4. An essay addressing the question "How has soccer helped you as an individual?"
