Dear MSYSA League Presidents and League Delegates:

The MSYSA Board of Directors recently approved changes to MSYSA Rule 2.18, MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-5, MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-8, MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-9, MSYSA Rule 3.7 E, and MSYSA Rule 3.8, subject to membership approval at the AGM or at a special meeting.

The change to MSYSA Rule 2.18 ([click here](#)) re-inserts section C once again allowing the publication and the promotion of Open House Activities provided member organizations and/or affiliated clubs adhere to the policies and procedures as established by the MSYSA State Office.

The change to MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-5 ([click here](#)) removes the verbiage referencing the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy and it relates to tryouts. With the elimination of Rule 3.8, the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy no longer exists.

The changes to MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-8 ([click here](#)) removes the verbiage referencing the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy and it relates to the Michigan Soccer Publication. With the elimination of Rule 3.8, the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy no longer exists.

The changes to MSYSA Rule 3.4 A-9 ([click here](#)) removes the verbiage referencing the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy and it relates to the commitment or signing of a player. With the elimination of Rule 3.8, the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy no longer exists.

The changes to MSYSA Rule 3.7 E ([click here](#)) re-inserts the final sentence referencing Open House Activities. Now that Open House Activities are once again allowed under Rule 2.18, Rule 3.7 E must address how Open House Activities relate to alleged poaching incidents.

The changes to MSYSA Rule 3.8 ([click here](#)) eliminate Rule 3.8 in its entirety. With full team practices and games now being permitted, there is no longer a need for the 2020-2021 Travel Team Formation Policy.
