

How to Enroll in the **NEW** MI Safer Sports Testing Program



Examples to be compliant with the MDHHS epidemic order

- 1) Use local testing sites
- 2) Contract with a vendor/lab
- 3) Procure your own antigen testing supplies
- 4) Enroll into the MI Safer Sports Testing Program and request antigen testing kits

*and follow MDHHS testing cadence



MI Safer Sports Testing Program



In-house School Sports *

- Principles, Superintendents, or another Administrator should submit ONE enrollment per school
 - EVERYONE needs to re-enroll both students and staffs, regardless of prior sub
- This enrollment will encompass ALL students in your school you would like to test.
 - Sports teams are mandated to test 1x weekly
 - You may also elect to test other students (band, drama club, robotics, general high school population) at the same cadence of 1x per week.
- Once this is submitted your local ISD will be able to see the number of tests that you have requested, and they will be allocated enough to accommodate each request.
- You will work with your ISD to collect 2 weeks worth of tests at a time.

* Water polo will enroll separately to ensure they have enough supplies for testing up to 3x per week



In-house School Sports cont.*

- You will continue to work with your local ISD to collect the tests as you need them.
- If you decide to add more students at any point you will need to submit a second enrollment form for those students.
- ISDs will continue to be stocked as needed
- By agreeing to participate in this program, you attest that you will:
 - Report each negative AND positive test
 - You have a CLIA Waiver
 - You have the ability to dispose of these tests via Biohazard Waste
 - You will abide by the regulations of the state and local health department
 - Participate in contact tracing
 - Your staff has been trained

* Water polo will enroll separately to ensure they have enough supplies for testing up to 3x per week
