State Cup Game Score Reporting (Phoning in Scores)

The winning team (or home team in case of a tie) is responsible for **REPORTING** the game scores of each State Cup Preliminary Game. Scores must be reported within 24 hours of each preliminary game. This is what gets the score posted online – not the referee-submitted online game report.

Failure to report the game score within 24 hours may result in a \$100 fine or game forfeiture. Teams can report scores via a phone or the website. Instructions for doing both are located below.

Reporting Scores Using the WEBSITE

1. Have the GotSoccer State Cup Game Report for the game in question at your disposal. This can be accessed at any time through the team's GotSoccer account.
2. Go to www.gotsport.com/events/scoring
3. Enter the Event ID and Event PIN number located at the top of the GotSoccer game report.
4. Enter the Game Number also located at the top of the GotSoccer game report
5. Enter the Final Score and hit the 'save' button.

Reporting Scores Using a PHONE

1. Have the GotSoccer State Cup Game Report for the game in question at your disposal. This can be accessed at any time through the team's GotSoccer account.
2. Call the Phone-In number at the top of the game report (904-758-0875)
3. Press 1 to update game records
4. Enter the Event ID number and then press the # button. Event ID numbers are located at the top of the GotSoccer game report.
5. Enter the Event PIN number and then press the # button. Event PIN numbers are located at the top of the GotSoccer game report.
6. Enter the Game Number and then press the # button. Game numbers are located under the date on the GotSoccer game report.
7. Press 1 to enter the game scores
8. Enter the HOME team score and then press the # button
9. Enter the AWAY team score and then press the # button
10. Press 1 to save the game scores
