## **General Information to Applicants**

- 1. This program of college tuition awards is administered by the Michigan State Youth Soccer Association.
- 2. Scholarships are in the form of tuition awards of \$2,000 and are to be used toward expenses in an accredited college, university, or community college beginning with the Fall of 2024.
- 3. This program is open to Michigan residents who are participating in a bona fide soccer program and are graduating high school seniors.
- 4. Applicants must have played on a MSYSA-affiliated team for at least 6 seasons (3 years).
- 5. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00.
- 6. Applicants need not play college soccer to apply.
- 7. All applicants receive notice of their status as soon as practicable after the selection process is completed.
- 8. Scholarships may be contingent upon proof of acceptance and enrollment in a full-time academic program at an accredited college, university, or community college in the Fall of 2024.

## **Application Requirements**

The MSYSA College Scholarship is due into the MSYSA State Office in its entirety no later than **November 1, 2023**.

A completed application must include the following items:

- 1. The MSYSA College Scholarship Application Form (signed & dated).
- 2. Separate pages containing the extra academic, athletic, and community service/volunteer details asked for on the MSYSA College Scholarship Application Form.
- 3. A separate page containing the essay requested on the MSYSA College Scholarship Application Form
- 4. A copy of your official high school transcript
- 5. A copy of your official SAT and/or ACT scores (if known/available)
