I. Current Rule:

Rule 3.6: C 2 Dual Rostering.

C. Dual Rostering.

2. A player may not play for more than one team in the same competition (meaning MSYSA sanctioned tournament, MSYSA State Cup, MSYSA member organization league division, etc.). A player must play on a team with the primary team's club in the MSYSA State Cup.

II. How the Rule Would Be Changed:

Rule 3.6 C. Dual Rostering.

2. A player may not play for more than one team in the same competition (meaning ~~MSYSA sanctioned tournament,~~ MSYSA State Cup, MSYSA member organization league division, etc.). A player must play on a team with the primary team's club in the MSYSA State Cup.

III. Rationale:

Most leagues allow dual rostering currently. This change provides MSYSA sanctioned tournaments the ability to permit dual rostering at their events as well. Players being forced to 'pick one or the other' if both teams are going to tournament creates issues for players/families.
