I. Current Rule:

Rule 3.6: Player Release, Transfer, Dual Registration

C. Dual Rostering.

3. In all cases of dual rostering involving a National League Conferences team, the NLC team must be the primary team.

4. In all cases of dual rostering involving a Michigan State Premier Soccer Program (MSPSP) team and a non-NLC team, the MSPSP team must be designated as the primary team.

II. How the Rule Would Be Changed:

C. Dual Rostering.

3. In all cases of dual rostering involving State Cup, a player may only play State Cup with a team from their primary team's club.

III. Rationale:

This rule change would accommodate clubs who have teams in multiple regional leagues such as NAL and NLC.
