MSYSA Field Insurance FAQs

When do I need a COI (Certificate of Insurance)?

All MSYSA affiliated leagues/clubs should have a COI for any fields/facilities they use for soccer activities.

Who can submit COI requests?

Any League Official who is listed on your current MSYSA league affiliation (officers on your Board of Directors).

Why hasn't my club/league received COIs for the new seasonal year?

Our insurance system rolls over to the new seasonal year every September. This means any COIs you had for the previously seasonal year are rolled over to the current year automatically on September 1st. A full list of your leagues/club's COI's is available upon request (email: esatterley@michiganyouthsoccer.org). *COIs will only be issued to leagues/clubs who have submitted league affiliation paperwork for the current seasonal year.*

Do I need to submit COI request ever year?

No. Once a COI have been submitted, they remain on file and will roll over each year unless we receive a request to remove a specific location.

Why can't I just have a COI in the name of my league/club as the certificate holder?

Blanket certificates create confusion on what is or isn't covered. Some may interpret blanket certificates to insure items or people that are not actually covered in our policy.

Who is covered under the MSYSA policy?

Anyone registered under the MSYSA umbrella (coaches, managers, players, volunteers, etc.) actively participating in an MSYSA sanctioned activity.
